If your account's registration type is any of the following: a bank, church, corporate, investment club, professional association, professional corporation, unincorporated association, limited liability corporation, or partnership, your account will be assigned to the Business Bank list. If your account is not any of the registrations listed, it will be assigned to the Consumer Bank List.

The order and composition of the Program Bank list may change at any time. **Please consult your Investment Representative with any question.**

You may contact your Investment Representative to designate a bank as ineligible to receive funds (otherwise known as “opting out” of a bank). Opting out of a Program Bank will affect the amount of your deposits eligible for FDIC insurance.

Excess Banks will accept funds without limitation and without regard to the Maximum Applicable FDIC Deposit Insurance Amount once funds equal to the Maximum Deposit Amount (as defined in the Bank Deposit Sweep Program Disclosure Document) have been deposited for you through the Bank Deposit Sweep Program in each Bank on the Program List.

It is your obligation to monitor the total amount of deposits that you have at each bank, including through bank accounts, certificates of deposits (“CDs”), and deposits held through other brokers for purposes of reviewing deposits which may be eligible for insurance by the FDIC.

FDIC insurance protects against deposit losses if an FDIC-insured bank fails. &Partners, LLC is not a bank and is not an FDIC-insured institution. Only those balances that are held within &Partners’ Bank Deposit Sweep Program (“BDSP”) and the BDSP’s participating banks are eligible for FDIC insurance. BDSP balances eligible for pass-through FDIC insurance coverage are subject to specific conditions and restrictions.
